Dear Dr. Chandolia,

Thank you for coordinating the abstract review for ICAR 2012. As the Editor of your Section (**Puberty & neuroendocrine regulation of reproduction**), you will be referred to as the **Chairperson** by the FASS Abstract Management System. Please see attached document on "Guidelines to Chairpersons". This document has all necessary information on how to access the abstracts and organize the review process. I have also attached a separate document on "Reviewer instructions". You can send this document to your reviewers or copy-paste its contents in the email that will be automatically sent by the FASS system. Considering requests from several countries, we had to extend the abstract submission deadline to Feb 6. The new deadline for completion of the first round of reviews is March 7, 2012. All decisions by the reviewers (and your decision to accept/reject/revise an abstract) must be completed by this date. Sections will be closed to the reviewers on March 7, but you will continue to have access to the system. The review process including the revisions by the authors and re-review must be completed by March 20, 2012. We had to rename several abstract sections to accommodate large numbers of abstracts in certain sections. Therefore, you might notice a slight change in the name of your abstract section.

Abstract review is a peer-review process and in as much, the abstract must undergo scientific scrutiny. Abstracts that don't meet this test should not be accepted. However, abstracts have been submitted from all around the world and considerable editing may be required. Section Chairpersons are urged not to reject abstracts because they require editorial help. Rather, assist the authors as much as possible in editing their abstracts. If the editorial process becomes over-whelming, the Local Organizing Committee is prepared to provide assistance. We do not want to lose good science from the proceedings because of poor English. If you require any help with this, please contact Dr. Reuben J. Mapletoft (reuben.mapletoft@usask.ca) who has agreed to help.

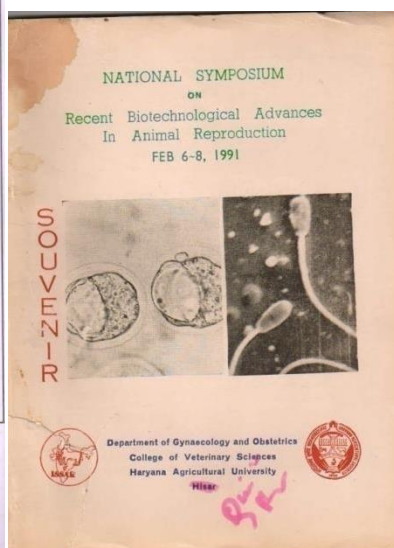

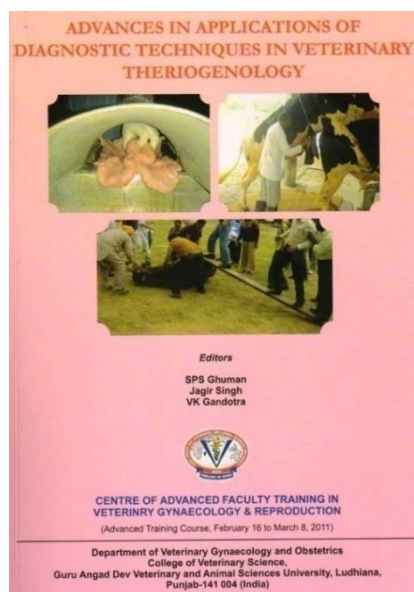

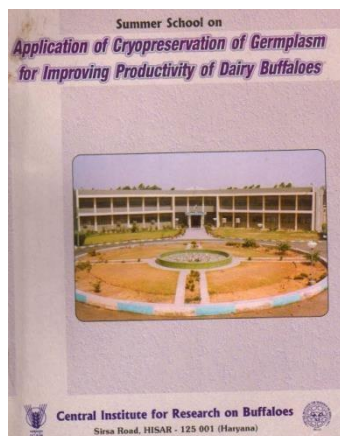

Preamble

The need of close cooperation in research and academic activities between various State Agricultural Universities and Veterinary Universities as well as ICAR institutes has been realized by ICAR. Lala Lajpat Rai University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences (LUVAS), Hisar, Haryana and Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (KVASU) Pookode, Kerala (hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Parties" and each a "Party") wish to establish a mutually beneficial relationship and to exchange scientists and knowledge with the goal of intensifying collaborative research and attract additional research funding. To formalize the cooperation, it has been agreed to sign a **Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)** between KVASU and LUVAS and will be subject to the following terms and conditions.

General Terms and Conditions

1. It is agreed that the collaboration between LUVAS and KVASU be established in the area of mutual interest to both the institutions for research and guiding research scholars leading to postgraduate (M.V.Sc. and Ph.D.) degrees. Accordingly, all the postgraduate students of LUVAS or KVASU can undertake their research work at either LUVAS or KVASU in the areas of mutual interest of both the institutes.
2. The Parties will support the sharing of research facilities commensurate with collaborative research projects. 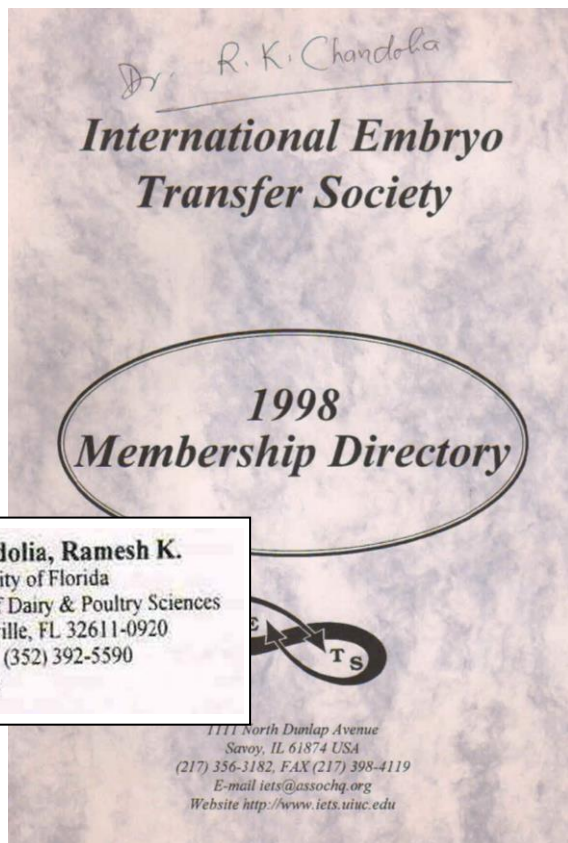

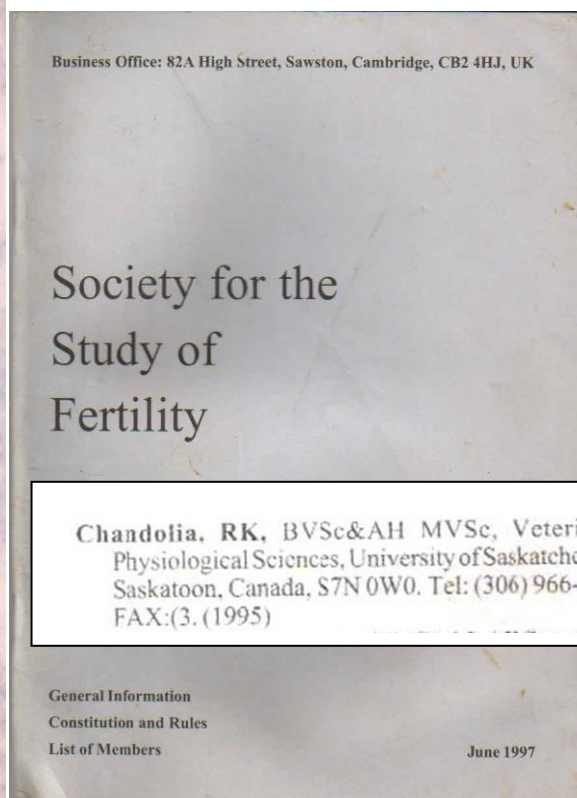

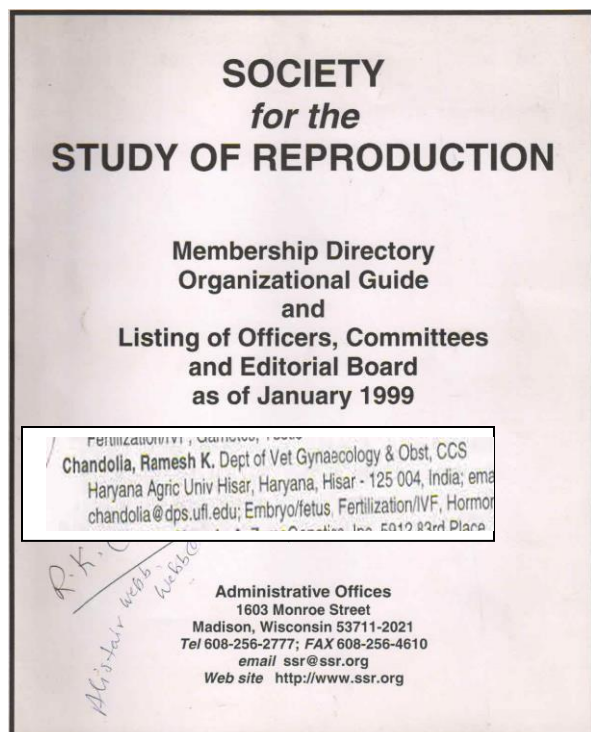
